Childhood Cancer Awareness Initiatives

HOPE reached students, teachers, youth, and communities across Kerala through structured awareness programs focused on early warning signs, timely diagnosis, and access to care.

Hundreds of students learned early warning signs and the importance of timely care.

•Oriental College of Teacher Education:

55+ trainees sensitised through interactive sessions.

•HOPE Konnect, Flavours’ Fiesta, Mahe:

Reached thousands, sparking conversations on awareness and early detection.

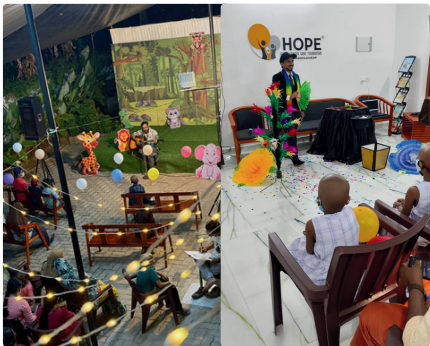

A family from Pollachi arrived at RCC with their child, Saran, battling cancer—without shelter or support. HOPE provided safe accommodation at the Ulloor Centre, essentials, and continuous emotional care.

Diagnosed with medulloblastoma, a rare brain tumour, just weeks after birth, Pathu faced multiple surgeries and intensive chemotherapy. Her first birthday was celebrated at HOPE Homes Kochi. Today, she is back home—living proof that your care creates second chances, **Because You Chose to Care.**

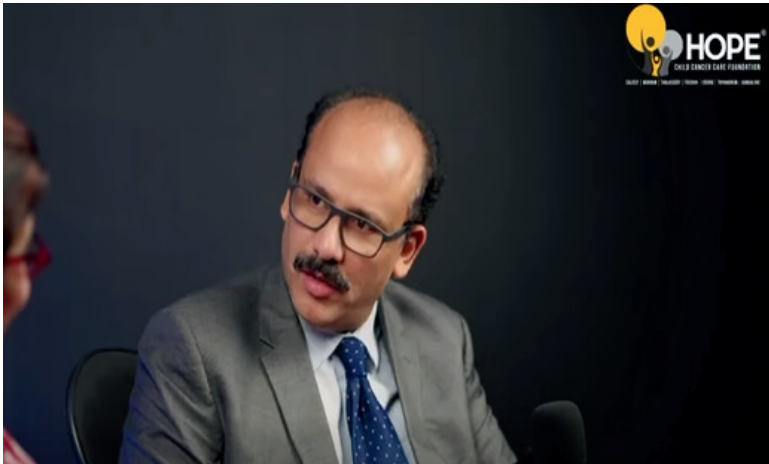
Expert Voice : HOPE Beyond Leukaemia (HBL)

- ✓ Our flagship initiative, HBL – HOPE Beyond Leukemia

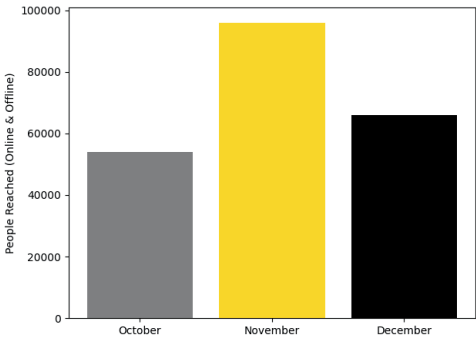
His words serve as a powerful reminder of why HOPE exists—to bring comfort, healing, and dignity into every child’s journey



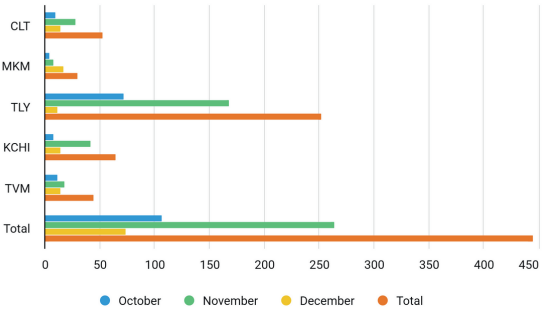

We warmly welcome the following team members who have joined HOPE across various locations:

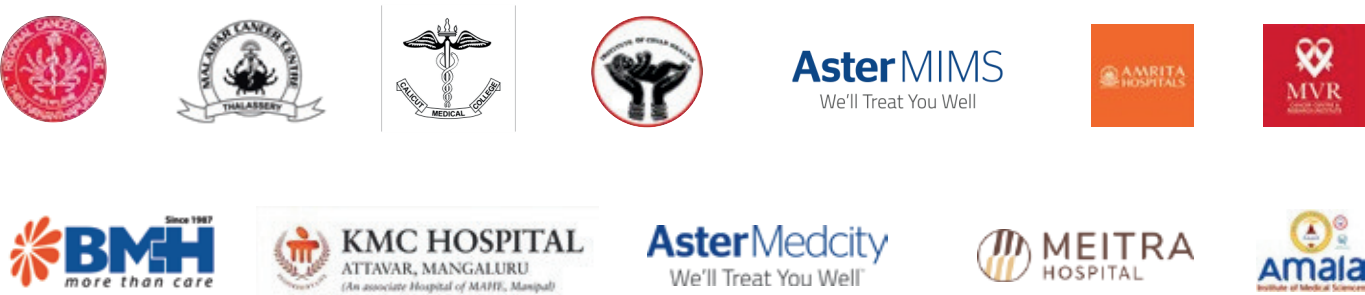
